

Symposium 6: instructions for access, and format and operation

Access to symposium

The access to **Symposium S6** is:

- On a first-come first-serve basis (max. number of 250 participants)
- Subject to a registration process, with the following instructions:

If you are a scientist that is presenting Oral or Poster in Symposium 6, you will be granted access by the Organizers without additional action.

Whether you are not presenting in Symposium 6, but you have registered and you are planning to attend to any of the two days planned for Symposium S6, you are required to send an email to the address: carlo.santoro830@gmail.com. Only in this case, the Organizers will grant you access to the Sessions. You may ask for access at any time before or during the 71 Annual ISE Meeting. However, the organizers would appreciate if you can ask for that access with some time in advance.

Format and operation of the symposium

Symposium S6 will be held in two days of oral presentations:

Wednesday September 2, from 2:00 pm to 6:30 pm (Central Europe Time)

Thursday September 3, from 2:00 pm to 6:30 pm (Central Europe Time)

The days will be organized as followed:

Wednesday September 2

- 2 Keynotes (37-38 minutes + 2 min of live Q&A)
- 5 Invited talks (17-18 minutes + 2 min of live Q&A)
- 7 PITCHs (5 minutes talk with no Q&A dedicated to PhD students)

Thursday September 3

- 2 Keynotes (37-38 minutes + 2 min of live Q&A)
- 5 Invited talks (17-18 minutes + 2 min of live Q&A)
- 8 PITCHs (5 minutes talk with no Q&A dedicated to Post Doctoral Fellow or early career scientists)

The selected platform for the online development of **Symposium S6** is Zoom.

The link will be provided to the presenters and to the other persons interested that previously requested access.

1st day: Link will be available on the WebApp

2nd day: Link will be available on the WebApp

All the presentations (Keynotes and Invited) will be live, except requested cases. The PITCH presentations might be live or pre-recorded. In the latter case, pre-recorded presentations are encouraged and preferred in order to minimize technical problems.

Each oral presentation will be projected as scheduled in the Symposium S6 Program.

Immediately after each presentation (Keynotes and Invited), there will be a 2-3-min live Q&A session with the presenter and moderated by the corresponding chairman. Questions might be written in the chat and the chairman will be in charge to read the question to the presenter. In addition, the written chat in Zoom will be open for more questions.

Poster Discussion Session.

On addition to Poster App available in the core meeting, Symposium 6 organizes the poster discussion sessions during the online Symposium 6 sessions, with a separate virtual discussion room assigned to each poster.

Two poster sessions will be held on the 2nd and 3rd of September, from 18:30 to 19:30 (Belgrade time). These poster sessions are offered via online conference tool BigBlueButton (BBB) and can be joined by following the link below:
